

### 2011 Flood And Moving Forward

Jody Farhat serves as the Chief of the Missouri River Basin Water Management for The Corps of Engineers' Northwestern Division. This year's topic she will discuss the historic flood of 2011 and how the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is committed to working with other agencies and stakeholders to best prepare the system for the 2012 runoff season and reduce flood risk throughout the basin. The system is vulnerable and many repairs will not be completed prior to the start of the 2012 runoff season. The Corps will maintain a flexible posture through the fall and winter as the remaining flood water is evacuated from the system. The operation of the reservoir system must be based on good data, science and engineering, and with consideration of ongoing critical repairs. The recently released report of the independent external review panel provided recommendations to improve the operation of the reservoir system.
