Lincoln Featured Speaker

Lynn has been with the Energy Office for 24 years. She is a Certified Energy Manager, Certified Lighting Energy Professional, International Energy Code Council Residential and Commercial Plans Examiner and Inspector. She had primary responsibility for the State's *School Energy Efficiency Program* and served as the lead on the *Rebuild Nebraska* initiatives, which included the development of the Energy Efficiency and Historic Preservation Planning Guide and the *Nebraska Green Build Program*. She conducted numerous energy audits under the *Rebuild Nebraska*, *Federal Energy Management Program* and *Climate Wise* programs. She also trained university interns for eight years to conduct energy audits and review building plans for code compliance. Her work includes providing technical assistance to Nebraska's Low Income Weatherization Program, analyzing energy building codes, providing education and information on the latest energy code to professional building organizations and the construction industry and providing technical assistance, training and information on energy programs and policies to participants in Energy Office programs. She also certifies house plans for code compliance for Housing and Urban Development, Veterans Administration and the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development.
